From the Pastor

"Dear children, let us stop just saying that we love each other, let us really show it by our actions" (1 John 3:18). You know, the best friendships and relationships are created by layers of kind actions. Here's a quick list that I once saw in an article:

1. **Rituals** (traditions) – it may be a weekly lunch date, annual shopping trip, or dinner and a movie once a month, but the best relationships are rich with memories accumulated over time.

2. **Gifts** – gifts are a symbol of time and energy invested in a friend or loved one. It's not the cost or size, it's the thought behind the gift that says, "He or she thought of me". So notes, cards, a favorite snack, phone call, text, or a tweet for no reason are all tiny statements of love.

3. Words – we're talking about words that are filled with acceptance and approval, so be cautious with criticism and generous with genuine praise. The Apostle Paul wrote, "So encourage each other and build each other up." It's been said that people become what we encourage them to be.

4. Listen – by definition, "listening" means "attention with the intention to understand". James, the brother of Jesus, wrote "Be quick to listen and slow to speak" (James 1:19). It's been said that "talking is sharing but listening is caring". As the old saying goes, "Ears aren't made to shut but the mouth is."

In this month of "love", let's try to see how many of these kind

actions we can put into practice. Remember the words of our Savior, "I am giving you a new commandment – love each other just as much as I love you. Your strong love for each other will prove to the world that you are My disciples."
